MSHDA Update including New Alliance with HUD

Donna McMillan is the Director of the Michigan State Housing Development Authority's ("MSHDA") Asset Management Division. As such, she oversees a multifamily rental bond financed portfolio of over 550 multifamily developments including around 55,000 household units, with approximately \$1.5 billion in loans receivable. Her office is also HUD's Performance Based Contract Administrator making her responsible for oversight of an additional approximately 400 HUD Section 8 assisted multifamily properties. Ms. McMillan joined MSHDA's staff in 1982 and has managed workouts, mortgage modifications and preservation transactions for more than 25 years.
